PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY DOCKET NO. 50-133 HUMBOLDT - INVESTIGATION - COMPLAINT AND ALLEGATIONS

Following is a status report of subject investigation, as of this date.

The inspection team of Messrs. Ward and North completed the investigation at Humboldt on May 28, except that no direct testimony was obtained from employees at the plant. The need for direct testimony is still under disucssion at this time.

Mr. North's feeder report will be transmitted to Ward on June 4. Assuming no additional investigative effort is required, Mr. Ward plans to transmit a "finished" report with an appropriate transmittal memo to CO:V on June 9, but in any case, no later than June 11, for review and subsequent transmittal to Headquarters.

A summary of the information obtained on May 26-28 has already been conveyed to Headquarters by telephone.
