Pacific Gas and Electric Company (Humboldt Bay) - An investigation is being conducted by CO in response to allegations made by a former licensee employee who wrote to the Commission, claiming that the company tolerated or encouraged questionable radiation safety practices. Included among the specific allegations were the following:

1. There were several instances dating back to 1966 wherein contamination was carried out of the plant and contamination release limits were not adhered to.
2. On one occasion during 1969, three stray radiation chambers at offsite monitoring stations had gone off-scale (10 mr full scale) during a two-week period.
3. Management refused employees permission to discuss problems with AEC inspectors.

The investigation is still in progress.
