Mr. Kingsbury,

This email is in response to your request dated February 20, 2020 and February 28, 2020, letters requesting to terminate your NRC license detailed above. In order to continue our review, we need additional information as listed below:

1. Please provide the following:
 - a. Confirmation that you are authorized to make legally binding commitments on behalf of Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. as either a senior management official or an authorized designee of senior management; **OR**
 - b. Provide a letter signed by a senior management official of Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. requesting the termination of NRC License # 47-25178-01 **AND** confirming the requests and statements made in your February 20 and 28, 2020 letters.
2. Please provide a copy of Ohio license Number 312104300002 for Kokosing Materials, Inc, demonstrating that they are authorized to possess the materials **AND** devices transferred from NRC License # 47-25178-01. Alternatively, they may provide me a copy of the license directly.

Additionally, in response to your questions concerning fee billing, please read the following response from our fees department:

Once NRC completes the termination any proration or refunds will be adjusted. Please refer to [§171.17 Proration of the Title of the Code of Federal Regulations \(10 CFR\)](#) for additional guidance. Any current invoices payments are still due in full. Any termination received after 10/1 through 03/31 is subject to a 50% proration and fees will be reduced by that amount once termination is complete.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. Please respond to my attention via email with a letter signed by senior management or an authorized designee and scanned into a pdf format, referencing mail control number 618317.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this request within **10 calendar days** from the date of this request.

Please be aware that you may request that certain portions of your submittal to NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
