

Vermont Yankee Feedwater Nozzle Integrity Evaluation

Dear Sir:

By Reference (b), we committed to performing a UT examination of our feedwater nozzle blend radius region and an analytically developed UT examination of the nozzle bore, during the 1983 refueling outage. Reference (c) requested that we provide you with a post-outage report detailing the results of these NDT examinations. as well as thermal sleeve monitoring data up to the current refueling outage.

In response to your request, we are providing you with the following enclosures:

- 1) Inspection Program Summary Nuclear Energy Services, Inc.;
- 2) NDT Examination Procedure;
- 3) Data Sample;
- 4) Diagram of the Area of Coverage on the inner Radius and Bore of the Nozzle;

- 6) Leak Detection System Date 1983 (Up to 1983 Refueling Outage); and
- 7) Analysis of Feedwater Nozzles and Evaluation of Thermal Sleeve Data.

If necessary, the complete inspection related data parkage can be made available to you for review at our plant site.
