## RESOLUTION NO. 389 OF 1983 INDIAN POINT POWER PLANT TO CEASE OPERATION.

Mr. Ingenito offered the following resolution which was seconded by Mr. Gdanskin

WHEREAS, the Legislature of Rockland County desires to reaffirm its prior resolutions with respect to closure of the Indian Point nuclear power plants and development of a Rockland County radiological evacuation plan, and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Services Committee of this Legislature has met, considered and unanimously approved this resolution, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Rockland County Legislature reaffirms its intent that the Indian Point Power Plants cease operation until such time as the Citizens Advisory Committee presents a radiological evacuation plan to the Rockland County Legislature no later than December 31, 1983, and which is thereafter approved by the Rockland County Legislature no later than February 1, 1984.
