The purpose of this submittal is to supplement the amendment request made by Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) on July 26, 1995, regarding the instrumentation surveillance extensions related to the 24-month fuel cycle for Millstone Unit No. 3. Specifically, this submittal includes information regarding the setpoint methodology for the reactor protection systems/engineered safety features actuation systems.

Enclosed are:

1. Two copies of WCAP-10991, Rev. 4, "Westinghouse Setpoint Methodology for Protection Systems, Millstone Nuclear Power Station Unit No. 3, 24-Month Fuel Cycle Evaluation," dated June, 1995 (Proprietary).

The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

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
Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR Section 2.790.

Proprietary Information Notice
