Enclosed is a letter from Megs Hepler, of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) dated March 23, 1995, transmitting the subject report for the Washington Nuclear Project, Unit 2 (WNP-2).

There were no Deficiencies identified during the September 13-14, 1994, exercise. However, twenty Areas Requiring Corrective Actions (ARCA) and ten Plan Inadequacies were identified. FEMA Region X staff will monitor the status of the corrective actions.

Please forward a copy of the enclosed FEMA letter and exercise report to the licensee and request that the licensee follow up with offsite officials on the Areas Requiring Corrective Action and Plan Inadequacies.
