Dear Ms. Pevear:

I want to thank you for all the help you gave my legal assistant, Pat Davis, when she called on July 5th. She told me that you spent quite some time helping her by providing names and phone numbers of town representatives. I really appreciate your efforts.

I regret that, due to the large number of interested towns, I am unable to invite town representatives to accompany me on my tour of Seabrook. Unfortunately, it would be physically impossible to tour a construction site such as Seabrook with a group of between 20 and 30 people. I had proposed that one town representative accompany me as the representative of all the towns. However, I was unable to get all the towns to agree to a single representative.

I enjoy meeting with people who live around the plants I visit and hearing their views. And I am particularly sensitive to the needs and interests of local government representatives. So I was disappointed that we could not work out some better arrangement in this case. However, in view of the strong local interest in the Seabrook plant and in my visit, I intend to prepare a trip report on my visit. I will send you a copy of the report, and I would be pleased to receive any written comments that you wish to provide.

I hope that this approach will provide an opportunity to share your views with me, and I would be pleased to consider other arrangements for a future visit to Seabrook that would provide a better opportunity for discussion. Thank you again for all your help.
