Terry,

We are being encouraged to leave as early as possible this afternoon, so I will not be working on your Corrected Copy today as I had expected. I will work on it tomorrow instead.

Let me make sure I have all of the items that need to be corrected. As we discussed, these are items that are different than are listed in our 'standard authorized materials' database, so all require a licensing reviewer to edit in the pdf after our system generates the pdf document. And as we discussed, because the Amendment 40 that you requested involved only the authorized users, I missed checking the authorized materials and did not see that editing was needed.

Here is what we discussed as needed:

Item 6.A needs to be revised to list the excepted radionuclides. These exceptions relieve you of financial assurance requirements

Item 6.B should list Nos. 84 through 98. Our standards are 84 through 96 so I chose that then did not edit it. We have a default of 84 through 108, which you already are authorized for in Item L. We agreed to make 6B the same.

Item 6J is a mixed-source standard and needs to be edited to include all the radionuclides in the mix.

Item 6V is mixed U233/U235 and needs to be edited to show both radionuclides

Item 6W, 6X and 6Y need to be edited to show the enrichments authorized.
