Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

On May 24, 1984, a fire barrier LCO was initiated to permit the installation of the IA conventional service water pump. This pump requires the use of the intake crane for pump installation. During the installation of the pump, the crane was rendered inoperable due to broken electrical connections in a section of conduit. This damage caused delay of the pump installation, and the specified seven-day time frame of the subject LCO has been exceeded. Until the completion of the repairs on the crane and subsequent installation of the IA conventional service water pump, appropriate stationed fire watches will be maintained.
