Purpose:

At the invitation of the Planning Commission (see enclosure 1), NMSS staff attended a public hearing regarding application by VEPCO for a Conditional Use Permit for a dry cask independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) on its Surry site.

Summary:

Marvin Smith made a presentation for VEPCO detailing the history of spent fuel storage management to the Planning Commission up to the present including the passage of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982. He then explained, from this basis, VEPCO's plans for managing Surry spent fuel until 1998 when the Department of Energy is expected to take such fuel for repository disposal or possible storage at a monitored, retrievable storage installation. A videotape of tests on Gesellschaft fur Nulkear Service, mbH, CASTOR model dry storage/transportation casks was also shown.

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

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Questions were asked of VEPCO by the Planning Commission and the public.

John Roberts then was asked to speak. He made a statement, which had been prepared with assistance from SG and IE (see enclosure 2). Questions were responded to by Roberts, Odell Smith and Don Burke. When the questioning ended, the planning Commission then voted to certify the VEPCO application for approval to the Surry County Board of Supervisors with an amendment that the Board not act until NRC approval of a license for ISFSI storage at VEPCO's sites.
