Declaration of an emergency classification at Alert level or above, or by direction of the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO.

ACTION STATEMENTS

Shift Radiation Protection Technician (SRPT)/Designee shall:

1. At the direction of the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO, proceed to the TSC to initiate its activation. Appropriate protective measures will be utilized for any adverse radiological conditions to be encountered in transit to the TSC.
2. Check the dose rates in the TSC. If greater than 100 mr/hr, consider evacuation within one hour (refer to EP IV-104). If greater than 1000 mr/hr, consider immediate evacuation. Proceed to an up wind location to avoid the plume.

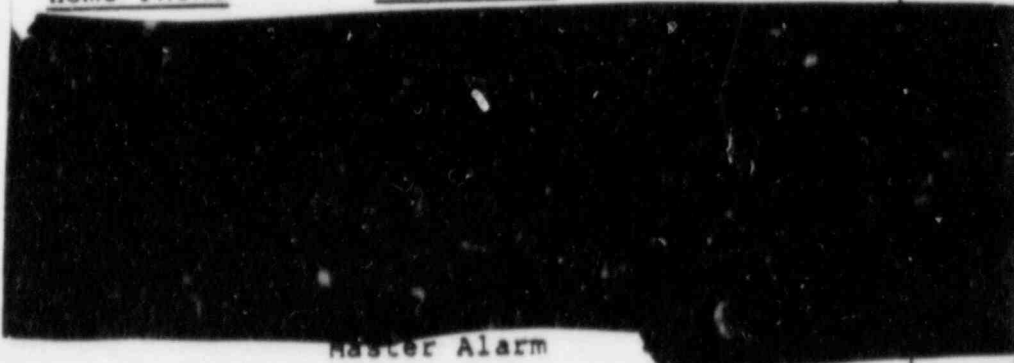

3. Establish contact with the Control Room and obtain a briefing on the incident and pertinent plant status. Record required information in the log book. Synchronize your watch with the control room.

4. Contact the senior Radiation Protection Supervisor. Provide him/her with the important details on the incident. The contacted Radiation Protection Supervisor should refer to EP IV-122 and decide on the number and level of personnel required to respond to the incident.

6. Contact the Control Point and ensure that on-shift personnel are accounted for. If dose rates are greater than 2 mr/hr at the control point, refer to EP IV-105.

ACTION STATEMENTS (cont'd)

7. Ensure that the NMC-CAM and RMS-2 monitors are operational in the TSC. Equivalent backup instruments should be used if either monitor is operable or if the readings are contradictory. Set-up necessary contamination control measures and equipment at the entrance and ensure all personnel entering the TSC are appropriately frisked.
8. Consider obtaining additional personnel assigned to other departments (i.e., Chemistry, I & C, Maintenance and Administration).
9. Inspect the TSC emergency equipment and ensure its readiness. Any missing or inoperable items should be replaced with equipment from the Control Point. The SAM-2/RD-19 counter should be turned on and allowed to stabilize.
10. If a request (for surveys, re-entry, etc.) is received, use the appropriate procedure to evaluate/plan/perform the task.
11. Use the Dose Calculation procedures to obtain dose estimates (EP IV-111, EP IV-113 or EP IV-114). If actual survey/plant monitor data is not available use default cases for calculation of possible doses. The applicable dose assessment portions of the Station Status Checklist will be completed and forwarded to the EDO, Radiation Protection Supervisor and other appropriate TSC members. The Station Status Checklist must be completed promptly to allow its transmission to the States within the required 30 minute time period. Additionally, until the EDO arrives at the TSC, this data will be phoned to the Control Room Accident Assessment Liaison to allow him/her to forward the data to the Senior Shift Supervisor.

ACTION STATEMENTS (cont'd)

12. As personnel arrive from off-site, direct them to their appropriate work locations.

NOTE

The approval of the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO shall be obtained prior to initiating the following:

1. Re-entry into evacuated areas.
 2. The initial dispatching of off-site survey teams.
13. When relieved by the Radiation Protection Engineer/Supervisor assume responsibility for environmental monitoring and coordination of on-site radiological monitoring teams and until the Radiological Support Manager (RSM) assumes duties at the EOF, the off-site radiological monitoring teams.
14. At the termination of the emergency, by direction of the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO, check TSC supplies and replenish as necessary.

Radiation Protection Engineer/Supervisor shall:

1. Report to the TSC when contacted by the TSC Radiation Protection Representative (backshift and weekends) or when notified of an emergency classification at Alert level or above, or when directed by the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO (normal dayshift).
2. Assume TSC activation duties and release the SRPT/designee to perform environmental monitoring and coordination of the on-site and off-site radiological monitoring teams.

ACTION STATEMENTS (con't)

3. After TSC activation is completed, assume control of all Radiation Protection activities on-site and off-site (radiation monitoring activities off-site will be transferred to the RSM when he assumes duties at the EOF), closely monitoring all activities being performed by radiation protection personnel. Ensure appropriate contamination controls have been established as required with regard to the incident.
4. Provide protective action recommendations as necessary to the Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO (refer to EP IV-108) until EOF is activated and RSM assumes duties.
5. Maintain frequent communications with the Control Point, the OSC, Senior Shift Supervisor/EDO and Radiological Support Manager (if EOF is activated).

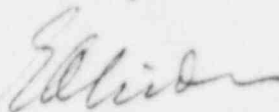

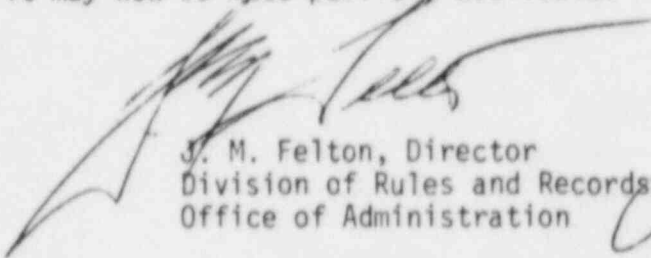

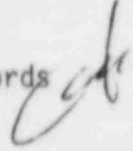
