SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-498/91-34; 50-499/91-34 (NOTICE OF VIOLATION)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. I. Tapia and other members of this office during the period December 21, 1991, through February 1, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your South Texas Project (STP), Units 1 and 2. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations of activities in progress.

An unresolved item is identified in Section 5.5. The adequacy of essential chiller maintenance procedures is unresolved pending additional inspection followup.

On the basis of the results of this inspection, certain of your activit's appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation is of concern because it represents a less than complete understanding of Technical Specification containment integrity requirements by a broad range of personnel in your s.aff. This violation was classified as a Severity Level IV violation because of minimal safety significance. The reactor coolant system pressure boundary was intact, and the main steam isolation valves and other main steam valves, although not leak tested, were closed. As a result there was no release path from inside the containment building to the outside of the containment building. Nevertheless, I encourage you to closely review the circumstances associated with this event when formulating your corrective actions.
