Long Island Lighting Co. (LILCO) fossil fueled and Shoreham plant employees belonging to the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) voted on Sunday July 8, 1984 to strike, rejecting LILCO's final offer of company stock in exchange for an immediate 5 percent pay cut, an increase in deductibles for medical and dental plans and elimination of some holidays.

Union officials are scheduled to formally report the strike vote outcome to a federal mediator and LILCO management today, at which time LILCO will have a chance to revise its offer. Barring any last minute LILCO offer revisions, the strike, which effects positions such as reactor operator, equipment operator, machinist, electrician, clerk, etc., is scheduled to commence tomorrow July 10, 1984.

Region I has reviewed Shoreham plant security arrangements for the impending strike condition and will continue to follow Shoreham status.
