

Plant Hatch - Units 1 and 2 Fitness For Duty Program

The data generated under the Fitness For Duty program from July 1991 through December 1991 has been reviewed and analyzed and no weaknesses have been identified.

The random pool contains not only those badged for unescorted access, but also those employees who may, in an emergency condition, be called upon to work at the site and may require unescorted access. Contractors are included in the pool while on site. Testing is performed on a nominal weekly basis to include swing shifts, weekends and holidays at a rate which will equal 100% yearly of the total population.

In summarizing management actions associated with the Fitness For Duty program, it should be emphasized that the incidence of confirmed positive tests has been low. Consequently, management actions relative to confirmed positive tests or other fitness for duty issues have been limited. Contractor employees screened as positive are denied access and no further action is taken by Georgia Power Company in these cases.
