

Dear Sir:

Generic Letter No. 82-33 transmitted to the Authority Supplement 1 to NUREG-0737. The requirements and guidance contained in Supplement 1 replaced the corresponding requirements for the five affected NUREG-0737 items. Generic Letter No. 82-33 requested, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(f) that the Authority furnish a proposed schedule for completing each of the basic requirements for items identified in Supplement 1. This generic letter also requested a description of our plans for phased implementation and integration of the emergency response activities. The Authority's plan and schedule were transmitted to the Commission by Reference 2. In accordance with the commitments made in Attachment I to Reference 2, the Emergency Operating Procedure Generation Package is enclosed.

Attachment I, Administrative Procedure No. 2.2 (Procedure for Emergency Operating Procedures), contains the Authority's Writers Guide, Verification Program, and Validation Program for our FitzPatrick plant.

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Attachment II, J.A. FitzPatrick Technical Guidelines For Emergency Operating Procedures, contains the plant specific guidelines. This document is based on the General Electric BWR Owner's Group Emergency Procedures Guideline, Revision 3, dated December 8,1982. These plant specific guidelines were prepared in accordance with the procedures in Attachment I.

Attachment III, Emergency Operating Procedure Training Program, summarizes the scope of operator training.

In accordance with the plan described in Attachment II of Reference 2, the symptom oriented Emergency Operating Procedures will be completed by December 31, 1984.
