On the basis of these outstanding obligations of the parties we hereby move that the time for filing briefs of all parties be extended such that

as provided in 10 C.F.R. \$2.762 briefs of Appellants are to be filed forty (40) days after service of the last remaining Partial Initial Decision in this proceeding. Briefs of the other parties would be due thereafter as provided in 10 C.F.R. \$2.762(c).

I am authorized to represent that Applicants, the NRC Staff and the State of South Carolina consent to the issuance of an Order granting this relief.
