Subject: Callaway Plant Technical Specifications - Appeals

In Reference (1), Union Electric Company (UE) requested an appeal meeting on three Callaway Technical Specifications. This request for appeal covered the following:

- (a) Technical Specification 3/4 4.9.3, "Overpressure Protection System;"
- (b) Technical Specification 3/4 6.1.6, "Containment Vessel Structural Integrity;" and
- (c) Technical Specification 3/4 6.3 "Containment Isolation Valves."

For Issue (a), the staff has performed a detailed review of the proposal along with additional information submitted by UE and has determined that the UE revision to Technical Specification 3/4.4.9.3 is acceptable as an interim measure. The staff's findings are documented in Supplement No. 3 to the Callaway Safety Evaluation Report. There will be a condition in the Callaway License requiring final resolution of this issue prior to startup following the first refueling outage.

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
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An appeal meeting for Technical Specification 3/4 6.1.6 was held on April 27, 1984. On May 4, 1984, the staff notified Mr. A. C. Passwater that its decision was to remain with the original version of the Callaway Specification. This is reported in Reference (2).

With respect to Item (c), the staff informed UE that there were provisions in the Standard Technical Specifications to accomplish the requested change and the staff has been working with UE to incorporate the necessary changes.

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
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
