
Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, please make available for public review at the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, Washington, D.C., a copy of the following:

1. All documents, including but not limited to written correspondence, internal staff memoranda, SECY papers, analyses, minutes of meetings, telephone logs, etc., pertaining to the level of design detail required for single stage licensing and standardized design certification. Please include all records of communication between and among any and all of the following parties: the Commissioners, NRC staff, members of the industry, and members of the public.
2. All documents pertaining to the August 25, 1983 meeting between the NRC staff and the Atomic Industrial Forum's Standardization Subcommittee, discussed in a September 19, 1983 memo from Dircks to the Commissioners regarding "Essential Elements of Design." Specifically included in this request are the minutes of this meeting and all NRC and industry documents produced in connection with this meeting, prior to, during, and since the meeting.
3. All papers presented at, and documents related to, the American Nuclear Society's Executive Conference on Single-stage Licensing, held on September 25-28, 1983, and the Atomic Industrial Forum's conference on licensing held on September 19-21, 1983.
