## ROGER B. HONLINGEL, hereby declares:

1. I am the Chairman of the Regional Assistance Committee, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FENSA), Region II, New York. I make this declaration in support of the Agency's Response to Suffolk County's Discovery Request.

2. Regional Assistance Committees were established in each region pursuant to 44 CFR 351.10. They consist of representatives from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Health & Human Services, Department of Energy, Department of Transportation, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Department of Commerce and other Federal departments as appropriate. It is chaired by the FEMA regional representative.

Pursuant to 44 CFR 351.10 and 351.20 through 351.28 each federal agency member of the RAC supports the RAC and has a specific assignment which includes the review of plans.

3. Pursuant to a request from the NMC, FINA arranged for a review of the LILCO Transition Plan by the Regional Assistance Conmittee and transmitted the results of the review to the MRC on March 15, 1984.

The representatives from six (6) federal agencies, who are members of Regional Assistance Committee (BAC) and two (2) FINA's consultant conducted the review of LHCO Transition Plan, Revisions I & HI. Their comments represent an evaluation of the plan for its compliance with MURSO-0654. It has been policy of our office to review all RAC comments for internal consistency and compliance with the requirements of MUREO-0654, before they are consolidated into one (1) plan review document (draft). In attempt to achieve an accurate final document, the draft plan review is discussed and deliberated by all members of the Regional Assistance Committee at a meeting. This process was also effectively used for the LHCO Transition Plan for Shoreham.

On January 20, 1984, Regional Assistance Conmittee met in FEMA offices in New York City and reviewed and deliberated the draft plan review document. The validity of each comment was discussed and necessary changes were made to assure that the final document reflected factual information. This RAC meeting resulted in reaching a concensus on the final plan review comments.

At the January 20, 1984 meeting various point of view were analyzed and conclusions and agreements reached on the final version of each comment by the members of the RAC as it relates to NURES-0654 planning criteria.

It is my judgement that the initial set of comments provided by RAC members are irrelevant at this point. I am also concern that by releasing the RAC individual comments which are predecisional, my ability to operate the Regional Assistance Committee will be severly weaken. The RAC members, in fact, may be very reluctant to provide me with written meterial which could be disclosed later at the ASLE hearing or other proceedings. Some of these comments may be sensitive in nature and their disclosure could have a negative impact on our relationship with the states, and local governments and utilities.

The release of the individual NAC comments and their personal notes will unquestionably undermine my ability to effectively operate the Regional Assistance Committee in providing useful guidance and assistance to the State, local governments and utilities as required by Executive Order 12148 of July 20, 1979 and FEMA rule, 44 CFR 350.
