Dear Ms. Puntenney:

This is in response to your letter dated February 13, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, four separate categories of documents relating to the Enrico Fermi 2 nuclear power plant.

Nina Toms, a member of my staff, has informed me that during a telephone conversation with you several weeks ago, you were advised that all of the information you are seeking is included in the NRC inspection reports for Fermi 2 which are available at the NRC's Local Public Document Room (LPDR) located at the Monroe County Library, 3700 Custer Road, Monroe, Michigan 48161.

During your conversation with Ms. Toms, you indicated that you have visited the LPDR and had difficulty locating the material you were looking for. Ms. Toms discussed this matter with Ms. Jona Souder, Chief of the Local Public Document Room Branch. However, since neither Ms. Toms nor Ms. Souder have been able to reach you by phone to discuss your problems with the LPDR in more detail, I am suggesting that you contact Ms. Souder directly on her toll free number (800-638-8081).

Further, Ms. Souder has advised me that Mr. William Carrier, of her staff, will be at the Monroe County Library during the week of April 23, 1984, to conduct their annual onsite evaluation of the Fermi LPDR collection. In addition, Mr. Carrier will be holding an evening workshop at the Library to acquaint members of the public with the LPDR program. You may be interested in attending the workshop. (Mr. Carrier may also be reached on the above telephone number)


