Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. Johnson and Tambling of this office on October 24-26, 1973, of operations at the Monticello plant authorized by AEC Operating License DPR-22, and to the discussion of our findings held by the inspectors with Messrs. Larson, Clarity and Anderson of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

A copy of our report of this inspection is enclosed and identifies the areas exemined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by the inspenters.

This inspection included an examination of your corrective actions as described in your letters of July 16 and September 7, 1973, which were in reply to our letters of June 28 and August 20, 1973, respectively. We have no further questions on those matters at this time.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of ABC requirements. The items and references to the pertiment requirements are listed under Enforcement Action in the Summary of Findings Section of the enclosed inspection report.

This notice is sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the ARC's "Rules of Prectice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. We have examined your corrective actions related to these violations and consider them to be resolved. No further correspondence on these two matters is required.

CONTRACTOR OF CONTRACTOR Based on the findings of this inspection, we note that the implementation of your quality assurance program has not met the achedula objectives outlined in your November 10, 1972 letter to Regulatory Operations, Resignanters. We request that you provide us, within 20 days, a future date by which you plan to have a formal program pursuant to 10 CFR Su, Appendix 8, placed fully into effect.
