This is in response to your letter dated March 13, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), three separate categories of documents relating to the "Seabrook Station Probabilistic Safety Assessment, Main Report."

The Seabrook Station Probabilistic Safety Assessment is currently in the PDR and may be found under accession number 8402070255. Inasmuch as neither contractor nor staff review of this study has begun, there are no review documents.
