SUBJECT: REPORT NOS. 50-369/83-48 AND 50-370/83-55

Thank you for your responses of March 30, 1984, to our Notices of Violation issued on February 29, 1984, concerning activities conducted at your McGuire facility. We have evaluated your responses and found that they meet the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your action to correct Violation No. 50-370/83-55-01 during future inspections.

After careful review of the basis for your denial of Violation Nos. 50-369/83-48-01 and 50-370/83-55-02, we agree with your position and have deleted this violation from our records. Our basis for withdrawal of the violation is that the Duke Power Company could not have reasonably taken any preventive or corrective measures beyond that which had been taken for a previous violation to preclude the violation. The employee willfully disregarded the company's policies or procedure adherence.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
