The subject material transmitted by Reference 1 supplements material previously transmitted by Reference 2 and is proprietary to Westinghouse. It is submitted for review to the NRC for acceptance as licensing material for reference on one or more applications.

The material will not be employed as part of a license application or other action identified in 10CFR2.790(a) at this time. It will be separately submitted with an Application for Withholding accompanied by an Affidavit meeting the requirements of 10CFR2.790(b) prior to such use.

Accordingly, we request that the material be treated as proprietary information within the provisions of 10CFR9.5(4), "Freedom of Information Act Regulations". If there is a need to make public disclosure of the material prior to a separate Westinghouse submittal for docket in accordance with the provisions of 10CFR2.790(a), please notify Westinghouse prior to making a disclosure determination.
