 - June 13 - UCLA's responses to CBG's discovery requests concerning UCLA's positions on the Taylor-Hafemeister testimony served or completed; CBG's discovery requests are to be promptly served so as to permit responses by this date.

- June 15 - Tentative date for serving prefiled written testimony.
 - June 25 - Hearing commences.
