SPURIOUS EMERGENCY ALARM SIGNAL

At approximately 2:00 P.M., PDT on May 22, 1984 a spurious emergency alarm was sounded in the standby diesel generator area. The activated siren is one of several that constitute the Site Emergency Signal. The Site Emergency Signal is actuated by the Control Room. Onsite workers have been instructed to immediately report to their predesignated assembly areas when this alarm is sounded. The siren was apparently activated at the time the Unit 2 standby diesel generator was started for testing. The licensee is evaluating the cause of the spurious alarm.

Response to the alarm was as planned. Immediate contact with the Control Room disclosed the alarm was spurious. Workers in the area who were evacuating to the assembly areas were instructed to disregard the signal and return to work. Because of possible misinter-pretation of the instruction to disregard the alarm, the licensee is considering the issuance of a memorandum to the contractors explaining the expected response and describing the alternative procedure of a security sweep for the known malfunction or temporary removal from service of the Unit 2 Site Emergency Alarm.

Unit 2 is under construction at this time. The licensee issued a press release on May 23.

Region V (San Francisco) was notified of this event by the resident inspector at approximately 3:30 P.M., on May 22, 1984. At about the same time a contractor employee also contacted Region V concerning this event. This information is current as of 1:00 P.M. on May 23, 1984.

This Preliminary Notification is issued for information only. Region V will maintain cognizance of and evaluate the licensee's corrective action during the next emergency preparedness inspection.
