Gentlemen:

On January 10, 1990, the U.S. Department of Labor's Wage and Hour Division in Hartford, Connecticut, received a complaint from an employee of Northeast Nuclear Energy Company at Millstone Nuclear Power Station Unit 2. The employee alleged that he was being harassed and discriminated against because he had raised safety concerns while performing his duties at Millstone Unit 2. We understand that in response to the alleged's complaints, the Wage and Hour Division secured an employee-employer conciliation.

Therefore, you are requested to provide this office, within 30 days of the date of this letter, a response which describes the events and your actions pertinent to this complaint. Specifically, you should include in this response copies of any investigative reports you have regarding this issue and the conciliation/settlement agreement secured with the alleged.

After reviewing your response, the NRC will determine whether enforcement action is necessary at this time to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The response requested by this letter is not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. No. 96-511.
