At 3:28 p.m. PDT on May 23, 1984, special natural circulation testing was acceptably completed on Diablo Canyon, Unit 1. This testing consisted of (1) natural circulation, (2) natural circulation with loss of pressurizer heaters, (3) natural circulation at reduced pressure, (4) natural circulation with loss of offsite power, and (5) natural circulation with up to two steam generators isolated. The completion of these tests concluded the Diablo Canyon Unit 1 low power test program. The licensee is cooling down the reactor and will perform maintenance in preparation for power ascension testing.
