SUBJECT: SETTLEMENT OF CLASS I STRUCTURES, TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION (TS) 3/4 7.12 - NORTH ANNA POWER STATION, UNITS NO. 1 AND NO. 2 (NA-''?) (TAC NOS. M67985 AND M67986)

The staff and its consultant, the Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL), have completed their review of your submittals dated March 10, 1988, as supplemented March 23, 1989 regarding the subject as noted above. As stated in the enclosed Safety Evaluation (SE), the NRC staff rejects your request to change the NA-1&2 TS 3/4 7.12 related to the monitoring of differential settlements of points 117 and 113R located in the service building (SB) and the main steam valve house (MSVH), respectively. While rejecting your request for changing TS 3/4 7.12, the staff finds acceptable your proposed alternate method of surveying to determine any additional differential settlement that might occur between the SB and MSVH. We are closing our TAC Nos. M67985 and M67986 regarding your submittals dated March 10, 1988 and March 23, 1989.

Your submittal dated October 2, 1989 regarding proposed TS changes for the Settlement Monitoring Program is being reviewed under separate TAC Nos. M82916 and M82917. Any additional correspondence regarding this matter should address these TAC Nos. Finally, the staff's ongoing review of your October 2, 1989 submittal is scheduled for completion by May 30, 1992.
