Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine, monthly inspection conducted by Messrs. M. M. Mendonca and M. L. Padovan of this office during the period of February 5, through March 24, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-76 and CPPR-69, and to the discussions of our findings held with Mr. Thornberry and other members of your staff at the conclusion of this inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection are described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection period, the inspectors also discussed the effectiveness of Pacific Gas and Electric's Quality Hotline with responsible onsite management. Additionally, Mr. J. B. Martin, the NRC's Region V Administrator, has discussed this matter with Mr. G. A. Maneatis, Pacific Gas and Electric's Executive Vice President. From these and other discussions with Region V personnel, it is apparent that both organizations recognize the importance of an effective Quality Hotline program. Accordingly, the NRC will be following your efforts to organize, staff, and administer the Quality Hotline program.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A.

Your response to this notice is to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 1.201 as stated in Appendix A, Notice of Violation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained herein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(i).

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Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be glad to discuss them when you.

The responses directed by this letter, and the accompanying Notice, are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
