SUBJECT: DOCKET NOS. 50-250 AND 50-251

This acknowledges the receipt of your letters of October 14, 1991 and March 5, 1992, which transmitted Revision 11 to the Turkey Point Training and Qualification Plan.

Our review of the changes has found them to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p). Accordingly, they are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.

One change requires clarification. This revision submits the following sentence in Section 3.2 on page 3-1; "The Security Supervisor may authorize members of the Security Department to be certified, based on their experience and background to perform any task listed in Appendix "B" providing the task does not require firearms certification. Such actions will be documented when they occur." 10 CFR 73.55 Appendix B(II)(D) states that "Each individual assigned to perform the security related task identified in the licensee physical security or contingency plan shall demonstrate the required knowledge, skill, and ability in accordance with the specified standards for each task as stated in the NRC approved licensee training and qualification plan." This section must be clarified to indicate that these Security Department members are "certified" based on a demonstration of their skills or knowledge. This was discussed between O. Masnyk of the NRC and F. Marcussen of your staff by telephone on March 24, 1992.
