SUMMARY: A retake of the Job Performance Measures portion of a requalification examination was administered to one Reactor Operator(RO). This individual passed the examination.

1.0 EXAMINATION RESULTS:

The individual passed his examination by both NRC and facility grading. There was 100% agreement between the facility and NRC evaluator on all individual JPMs and associated questions.

3.0 GENERAL COMMENTS:

There were two critical steps misidentified due to apparent typographical error, and two instances of steps identified as critical that did not have to be. For one JPM, the task standard essentially "gave away" the JPM and had to be changed. For another JPM, the standard of successful completion for one critical step needed to be detailed to a greater degree than "operator simulates doing this step." These changes were made prior to conduct of the examination. Overall, the required changes and quality of examination material were average. Facility personnel were very cooperative during exam validation, and all requested changes were accomplished.

4.0 EXIT MEETING:

An exit meeting was held with the facility evaluators at the completion of the examination. Examination and validation results, comments, and observations were discussed. Formalized facility results were requested within 10 working days as required by the Examiners Standards.
