ORDER

On June 18, 1991, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issued a Memorandum and Order, LBP-91-28 (June 18, 1991), that denied the Seacoast Anti-Pollution League (SAPL) standing to intervene in an amendment proceeding concerning the transfer of Public Service Company of New Hampshire's ownership interest in the Seabrook Station. The Board indicated that its order could be appealed in accordance with 10 CFR 2.714a(a), which requires the appellant to assert an appeal by filing a notice of appeal and an accompanying supporting brief within ten days. Although SAPL filed a notice of appeal on June 28, 1991, SAPL did not file its brief until July 23, 1991. SAPL acknowledges that, due to error on its part, its brief was filed outside the time allowed under 10 CFR 2.714a(a).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.772 and without prejudice to the Commission's determination whether SAPL's appeal should be

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dismissed for failure to file its brief on time, the NRC staff and the licensees may file a reply to SAPL's brief by August 8, 1991.


