SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 91-11, "RESOLUTION OF GENERIC ISSUES 48, 'LCOs FOR CLASS 1E VITAL INSTRUMENT BUSES,' AND 49, 'INTERLOCKS AND LCOs FOR CLASS 1E TIE BREAKERS,' PURSUANT TO 10 CFR 50.54(f)" FOR COMANCHE PEAK STEAM ELECTRIC STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2 (TAC NOS. M82397 AND M82398)

On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11, which contained the staff resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required licensees to certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters or other onsite power sources for VIB, and tie breakers. If procedures do not exist, a justification demonstrating the reasons why the controls are not needed is required.

By letter dated February 3, 1992, you responded to the GL. You indicated that procedures for time limitations and surveillance requirements are in place at your site.

The staff has reviewed your response and finds that it meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11. This completes the staff's activities on TAC Nos. M82397 and M82398.
