Subject: Transmittal of Technical Evaluation Report Regarding Control
of Heavy Loads in Accordance with NUREG-0612 at Comanche Peak
Steam Electric Station (Units 1 and 2)

Enclosure 1 contains a technical evaluation report, prepared by the staff's consultant, which is hereby forwarded for your review and comment. The report findings and conclusions were predicated on information provided by Texas Utilities' letters dated August 7, 1981, October 8, 1981, March 1, 1982 and July 8, 1983, in response to the criteria and guidelines in Section 5.1.1 of NUREG-0612 (the staff's Multiplant Item C-10 or Phase I evaluation as stated in NRC Generic Letters dated December 22, 1980 and February 3, 1981). Enclosure 2 contains a synopsis regarding the staff's interpretation in addressing the guidelines of NUREG-0612 which may be useful in assessing the open items identified in the technical evaluation report.

The staff is prepared to discuss your comments and proposed resolutions regarding the open items identified in a conference call with their consultant. Please advise Mr. John J. Stefano of my staff when such a conference call may be arranged and scheduled.

Subsequent to the conference call, you will be expected to formally document your resolutions of the open items to enable the staff to complete its evaluations and submit their findings to the Licensing Project Manager. Your letter should also indicate or provide information required by the staff to complete its Phase II evaluations, i.e., on Sections 5.1.2 through 5.1.6 of NUREG-0612 (Multiplant Item C-15 evaluations).
