The report findings and conclusions were predicated on information provided by Texas Utilities' letters dated August 7, 1981, October 8, 1981, March 1, 1982 and July 8, 1983, in response to the criteria and guidelines in Section 5.1.1 of NUREG-0612 (the staff's Multiplant Item C-10 or Phase I evaluation as stated in NRC Generic Letters dated December 22, 1980 and February 3, 1981). Enclosure 2 contains a synopsis regarding the staff's interpretation in addressing the guidelines of NUREG-0612 which may be useful in assessing the open items identified in the technical evaluation report.

Your letter should also indicate or provide information required by the staff to complete its Phase II evaluations, i.e., on Sections 5.1.2 through 5.1.6 of NUREG-0612 (Multiplant Item C-15 evaluations).


