Subject: Use of Hafnium Control Rods at Callaway

In your letter dated May 3, 1984, you expressed a desire to know about the staff review of hafnium control rods. I would like to address your request by first noting that the use of hafnium control rods is not an "experiment" at Callaway. There are several hundred reactor years of operating experience from both naval and commercial reactors that have used hafnium as a control material. The most recent use of hafnium in a commercial reactor for an extended period of time was at the Yankee Rowe Plant where this material was used, with acceptable results, for approximately nine years.

The use of hafnium control rods at Callaway has undergone NRC Staff review of both plant-specific design information submitted by Union Electric (UE) as well as any generic documentation, such as topical reports, which may have been provided by Westinghouse Electric Corporation. Based on its review of the above information and the operating experience from other reactors, the staff concluded that the use of hafnium at Callaway was acceptable. There will be a condition in the Callaway License which requires that UE perform a visual inspection during one of the first five refueling cutages. This precaution is to confirm that the design performs as expected. The above staff review and license condition are discussed in the Callaway Safety Evaluation Report (SER) and Supplement No. 2 to the SER.
