CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: We will try to get the order out this afternoon sometime. Anything more to come before us?

MR. CHILK: Mr. Chairman, they never took a vote on a short notice meeting.

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Can we do that?

(Chorus of ayes.)

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: We will adjourn.
