SUBJECT: GESSAR REVIEW OF SUPPRESSION POOL SOURCE TERM ATTENUATION

In comparing discussions of credit claimed by GE for suppression pool source term attenuation in the GESSAR application, it was noted the safety review did not claim substantially more credit than in previous GE analyses, but that a substantial increase in credit was being proposed in the PRA. Because of this anomaly and allocated AEB resources, I attempted to obtain clarification through the PI of GE's intent with respect to the safety review. The PI was unavailable and his acting Branch Chief, H. Bernard, suggested I contact the GE licensing representative directly. On August 16, I spoke with Jack Fox and requested clarification of GE's intent. He informed me GE will request greater credit in the safety review within about a week.

To accommodate the two reviews, AEP will advise the PI of any potential scheduling problems within a week of receipt of the anticipated GE letter.
