The NRC staff granted LILCO this exemption in its letter of September 11, 1991. The NRC staff has completed its review of LILCO's proposed Requalification Program and finds it acceptable based on the Shoreham possession only and the September 11, 1991, 10 CFR Part 55 exemption.
