SUBJECT: SHOREHAM LICENSED OPERATOR REQUALIFICATION TRAINING PROGRAM

The Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) in its letters of August 31, 1990, and July 1, 1991, submitted its proposed Shoreham Nuclear Power Station Licensed Operator Requalification Program (Requalification Program). In addition, LILCO included in these submittals a request for a limited exemption from the requirements of 10 CFR Part 55 Operators' Licenses. The NRC staff granted LILCO this exemption in its letter of September 11, 1991. The NRC staff has completed its review of LILCO's proposed Requalification Program and finds it acceptable based on the Shoreham possession only and the September 11, 1991, 10 CFR Part 55 exemption.
