Dear Mr. Vaden:

This is in further response to Mr. Doug McInnis' letter dated July 19, 1983, requesting documents relating to construction flaws at Carolina Power & Light Company's Shearon Harris Nuclear Plant.

Appendices A, B, and C are a list of documents responsive to your request. The documents being disclosed to you in their entirety are identified on Appendix A with an "R" next to the listed document. These documents and portions of the other documents listed on the Appendix which are being disclosed to you are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC and the NRC Local Public Document Room located at Wake County Public Library, 104 Fayetteville Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27601. In order to obtain access to these documents, please contact Mr. Roy Dicks at the LPDR on (919) 755-6092. The documents listed on Appendix C are already available at the PDR. Copies may be purchased by writing to the PDR. The charge for reproducing records located at the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Literature Research Company, a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed directly by Literature Research Company for the reproduction charges plus tax and postage.

Names of alleged and other identifying details have been deleted from documents 5, 7, 8, 68, 69, 70, 72, 76, 77, 103, 111, and 112 of Appendix A. The deleted names of alleged and their identifiers represent individuals who are confidential informants who provided information to the NRC during agency's investigative effort. Because disclosure of this information would disclose the identity of confidential sources, it is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (7)(D) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(D)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(7)(iv) of the Commission's regulations. The nonexempt portions of the documents identified above are being disclosed.

Certain names, home addresses, home telephone numbers, and other personal identifying details have been deleted from documents 2, 5, 9, 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20, 21, 30, 31, 32, 35, 40, 41, 42, 44, 49, 50, 51, 62, 64, 73, 74, 75, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 92, 98, 99, 104, 105, 106, 107, 109, 108, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, and 115 for the following reasons.

First, certain of the deleted names are of allegeders who furnished unsolicited information to the NRC. The NRC, in reviewing the totality of the circumstances under which the information was provided, believes that disclosure of the names of allegeders and their personal identifiers would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy because it could jeopardize their current and future employment, as well as their standing in the community.

Second, certain names of individuals and other identifying information have been deleted because the individuals are supervisors, co-workers, and others about whom allegations were made or who were mentioned in the description of the allegations. To disclose the identity of these individuals in a preliminary agency record which does not reflect the agency's findings regarding the validity of the allegations or incidents described would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of these individuals. Therefore, the names and other identifiers deleted from the allegations are being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (6) and (7)(C) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6) and (7)(C)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(6) and (7)(iii) of the Commission's regulations. Documents 105, 106, 107, 108, 110, 113, and 115 are being withheld in their entirety. The nonexempt portions of the remaining documents identified above are being disclosed.

The documents listed on Appendix B constitute investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the disclosure of which would interfere with an ongoing enforcement proceeding. Disclosure of this information would allow those being investigated to learn the scope, direction, and focus of the NRC investigatory efforts, and thus could possibly allow them to take action to shield potential wrongdoing or a violation of agency requirements from NRC investigators. These documents are being withheld in their entirety pursuant to Exemption (7)(A) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(7)(i) of the Commission's regulations.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 and 9.15 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for the denial of the information withheld from the documents listed on Appendix A are the undersigned and Mr. James P. O'Reilly, Regional Administrator, RII. The person responsible for the denial of documents listed on Appendix B is Mr. Ben Hayes, Director, Office of Investigations.


