**SUBJECT:** QUALIFICATION OF CRAFT PERSONNEL (REFERENCE CASE 2-096)

The Region II Investigative Staff was notified by the State of North Carolina Department of Labor that DCL had received written allegations concerning the improper certification of welders, pipefitters, carpenters and craft supervisory personnel at the Carolina Power and Light Company's (CP&L) Sharon Harris facility.

The individual failed to respond to a letter from us requesting specific details regarding his concerns. However, I have enclosed a Statement of General Concerns for whatever action you deem appropriate. The Investigative Staff plans no further action on this case.
