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## STATEMENT OF CONCERNS-2F017B

- 1. The QA Director has ordered an individual to confine his activity to areas within his discipline only. For example, if during the inspection of an electrical cable tray, a welding and/or mechanical problem is found and the electrical aspects are acceptable, he is to restrict his comments to the electrical only and make no comments on the other problems. No specific examples could be provided.
- 2. The QA Director has instructed an individual not to issue NCRs for QC inspection reports found to contain discrepancies. Instead, the individual was instructed to bring the problem to the responsible party and have it corrected. The following is an example of the above: Form TP-09, Concrete Embedded Electrical Equipment Inspection form, for pour numbers 1-ACSL-305-005 (1/14/81) and 1-ASCL-305-007 (2/4/81). No other examples could be given.
