Areas Inspected: Routine, unanrounced physical security inspection Tnvolving: Management Support; Protected and Vital Area Physical Barriers, Detection and Assessment Alds: Protected and Vital Area Access Control of Personne1, Packages and Vehicles; Power Supply; Testing and Maintenance and Compensatory Measures; Security Personnel Training and Qualifications; Followup to Previous inspection Findings; and a reactive review of a Fftness-For-Duty (IFD) event.
Results: One violation involving a failure to conduct a for-cause test was Tdentified. This violation demonstrated an additional concern because management personnel were aware of the incident and failed to adequately implement your FFD program.
Inspection results showed that licensee performance regarding implementation of the security program was good. Positive inspection results in the areas of management involvement were evident. Management places emphasis on attaining a level of performance that exceeded regulatory requitements. Securtty staffing was ample and security personnel (licensee and contractor) were knowledgeable in implementing security program requirements.
