SUBJECT: WOLF CREEK GENERATING STATION - RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 91-11,
"RESOLUTION OF GENERIC ISSUES 48, 'LCOs FOR CLASS 1E VITAL
INSTRUMENT BUSES' AND 49, 'INTERLOCKS AND LCOs FOR CLASS 1E TIE
BREAKERS' PURSUANT TO 10 CFR 50.54(f)" (TAC NO. M82489)

On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11 which contained the staff resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required that the licensees certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters or other onsite power sources for VIB, and tie breakers.

By letter dated October 24, 1991, you responded to the GL. You indicated that the Wolf Creek Generating Station Technical Specifications conform to the Westinghouse Standardized Technical Specifications (STS). The STS were included in the GL as a mechanism to satisfy the associated requirements for resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49.

The staff has reviewed your response and finds that it meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11. This completes the staff's activities related to TAC No. M82489.
