SUBJECT: NRC GENERIC LETTER 89-13, "SERVICE WATER SYSTEM PROBLEMS AFFECTING SAFETY-RELATED EQUIPMENT" (TAC NO. M73991)

By letters dated January 30, 1990, and December 23, 1991, Toledo Edison Company submitted its responses to the subject generic letter for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1. You have implemented either the recommended action contained in the generic letter or an equally effective alternative course of action for each of the five recommended actions. Therefore, Tac No. M73991 is closed.

We remind you that if a licensee chooses a course of action different from the recommended actions of the generic letter, the licensee should document and retain in appropriate plant records a justification that the heat removal requirements of the service water system are satisfied by use of the alternative program.
