In accordance with Section G.5, Task Order Procedures, of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Mcdification No. 1 to Task Order No. 152 which (1) increases the number of reviews for walkthru examination outlines from "3" to "4", (2) increases the number of walkthru operating examinations to administer and grade from "3" to "4", and (3) increases the task order's ceiling amount by \$2,635.00 from \$31,215.00 to \$33,850.00. The effort shall be performed in accordance with the revised Statement of Work which is enclosed and Sonalysts, Inc.'s technical proposal dated June 25, 1992, incorporated herein by reference. Accordingly, the task order is hereby modified as follows:

The second paragraph of the definitization letter of the basic task order is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:
