SUBJECT: VIEWS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION REGARDING THE CALLAWAY HISTORIC RESOURCES MANAGEMENT PLAN (TAC NO. M80675)

Enclosed is a copy of a letter dated September 23, 1991, from the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (the Council). The Council has concluded that further consultation amongst the various parties to the proposed programmatic agreement would not be productive, and urges the NRC and Union Electric Company (UE) to continue efforts aimed at protecting and preserving the archaeological sites on UE's Callaway County property by using UE's Resources Management Plan in effect there since 1983.

The three archaeological sites within the Callaway nuclear power plant's Maintenance and Operations (M/O) Areas, as identified in UE's Resources Management Plan, are subject to the requirements of Appendix B (the Environmental Protection Plan) to the Callaway license (NPF-30) issued by the NRC. Amending Appendix B in light of the Council's letter will take into account any changes affecting the three archaeological sites in the M/O Areas that may have occurred since NPF-30 was issued. This updating of Appendix B will help ensure that UE's efforts to protect and preserve the cultural and historical resources at its Callaway site remain successful, and will help the NRC meet its National Historic Preservation Act obligations consistent with the NRC's authority under the Atomic Energy Act.

Accordingly, the NRC requests that UE submit a license amendment application relevant to the matters raised in this letter and the Council's letter.
